The INCOSE Technical Director is an appointed Director position with a two-year term of Office. The Technical Director is a voting member of the INCOSE Board of Directors and focuses on the leadership, management and governance of INCOSE's diverse technical activities across the range of systems engineering practices in different domains around the world.

Responsibilities:

- Prepares, Coordinates and Communicates Technical needs into the INCOSE Long Range and Annual Operating Plans
- Manages the technical aspects of the INCOSE Annual Operating Plan
- Maintains an effective organization to facilitate the engagement of systems engineers from diverse backgrounds and with wide ranging interests
- Ensures the effective governance, including management, control and review, of INCOSE's technical information
- Participates in all BOD meetings
- Serves on other committees as assigned

Authority:

- Chairs the Technical Leadership Team (TLT)
- Voting Member of the BOD
- Member of the Planning & Budgeting Committee
- Functional Owner of INCOSE Policies: REC-103, REC-107, TEC-100, TEC-101, TEC-102, TEC-103 and TEC-104

Accountability:

- As stipulated in the INCOSE Bylaws, ADM-101 and BOD-100

Required Skills:

- Strong oral and written communication skills
- Able to communicate effectively across international and cultural boundaries
- Broad understanding of the diversity of systems engineering practices and application sectors
- Experience of the leadership and coordination of activities within a volunteer organization
