This year's event will feature a talk starting at 7 PM by UNM Computer Science and Santa Fe Institute external professor **David H. Ackley** entitled **Robust-First Computing: Beyond Correctness and Efficiency**. Dr. Ackley will discuss how traditionally, computer science and engineering has valued efficiency highly, but efficiency and robustness are at odds over redundancy, which robustness requires, but efficiency eliminates. This talk argues we could do better, and should, by recognizing and managing that tradeoff explicitly.
