49 participants (51 registered), feedback form had 20 responders (most students not present at final session).

- Glad they came question averaged 4.65 out of 5, all 5s and 4s except one 3: 5(14), 4(5), 3(1)
- Do it again question averaged 4.60 out of 5, all 5s and 4s except one 3: 5(13), 4(6), 3(1)

What you liked: KEYNOTE SPEAKER!! Interesting topics; good collaboration process.

What you didn't like: Time needed for Day 2 activities maybe too long. One of the sessions I participated in "finished" 1 hr. early. Maybe shorter day 2 sessions and end earlier (for travel considerations) or add other activities. Someone mentioned that the same topics were addressed last year; I would recommend minimizing this to keep things from getting stale/redundant.

To make it more effective: One of my sessions came up with an action plan with suggested activities. Perhaps in addition to the existing types of activities/discussions, some activities from the action plan be added.

What you liked: Interacting with the students, hearing new perspectives.

What you didn't like: There are many topics, consider reducing the # of topics. There are not many people to many topics. The EWLSE dinner is a good idea; however, we were separated.

To make it more effective: Reduce # of topics; reduce total time to 1 ½ days. First day 7 hours; Saturday 8:30 – 12:30.

What you liked: Doing exercises (active). Small group interaction.

What you didn't like: Discussions that just involved sitting in a chair (felt like it was 1-1 communication with the facilitator rather than the group. Poor cell phone reception, especially in Workman.

To make it more effective: Templates and facilitation training for facilitators to make the experience more consistent.

What you liked: The opportunity to speak mind and throw 2 cents in.

What you didn't like: Ballroom "C" was freezing.

To make it more effective: Invite students from the school (NMT).

What you liked: I liked the workshops from the 1st day. They helped us get informed better on the topics. The networking opportunities were great.

What you didn't like: I didn't like that most professionals would ignore the students because most students mainly wanted to network and they wouldn't listen to us.

To make it more effective: Shorter conferences and workshops. Make it bigger so that more students can come. Give students opportunities for scholarships and internships.

What you liked: The different opinions and perspectives of each participant that bring a more in depth look at the topics, as well as all the information provided.

What you didn't like: Sometimes certain topics and subtopics weren't clear enough and made it hard to understand.

To make it more effective: Clearer topics and more information on each one.

What you liked: Forum venue.

To make it more effective: More little breaks. Less talking, more action!! Implement this in real life.

What you liked: Interaction with experienced attendees.

What you didn't like: Lack of consolidation of redundancy.

To make it more effective: Make activities available (like INCOSE testing or potential side tours)
