



## INCOSE Past President Eric C. Honour (1997)

**Eric C. Honour** is a former President of INCOSE. He has been a systems engineer, engineering manager, and program manager at Harris Information Systems, E-Systems Melpar, and Singer Link, preceded by nine years as a US Naval Officer flying P-3 aircraft. He has led or contributed to the development of 18 major systems, including the Air Combat Maneuvering Instrumentation systems, the Battle Group Passive Horizon Extension System, the National Crime Information Center 2000, and the DDC1200 Digital Zone Control system for heating and air conditioning. He is an accomplished presenter, teaching courses in various systems engineering and program management topics at college and corporate levels. He was the founding Chair of the INCOSE Technical Board in 1994, was elected to INCOSE President for 1997, and was Director of the INCOSE Systems Engineering Center of Excellence (SECOE) 1999-2004. He was selected in 2000 for Who's Who in Science and Technology and in 2004 for the INCOSE Founders Award. Mr. Honour now heads Honourcode, Inc., a consulting firm offering effective methods in the development of system products through training, on-the-job assistance, and task performance. Mr. Honour has a BSSE (Systems Engineering) from the US Naval Academy, MSEE from the Naval Postgraduate School, and PhD from the University of South Australia based on his research into Systems Engineering Return on Investment (SE-ROI).
