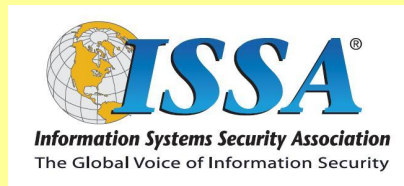
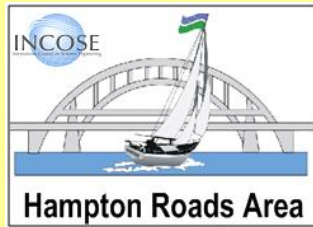

Abstract and Paper Requirements

- Abstracts for papers and presentations will be accepted through September 24, 2010
- Abstracts are not to exceed 300 words
- Technical Papers not necessary for presentation acceptance
- Papers not to exceed 10 pages including references and biographies

Student Poster Presentation Requirements

- Abstracts for student poster presentations will be accepted through September 24, 2010
- Abstracts are not to exceed 300 words
- Students must be pursuing a BS, BA, MS, MA or PhD
- Poster size (can be a composite of more than one poster) not to exceed 3 feet in height and 3 feet in width. Student responsible for structure to support poster (e.g. easel, table or other support). Posters cannot be attached to the walls of the facility
- Desired poster presentation topics are those that are in line with the event theme; however, other topics will be considered
