**Directions from NG Newport News:**

1. NORTHEAST on 41<sup>st</sup> Street towards US 60 E / Huntington Avenue.
2. Turn RIGHT onto US-60 E / Huntington Avenue
3. Merge onto I-664 N / Hampton Roads Belt via the Ramp on the LEFT toward HAMPTON
4. Merge onto I-64 W via EXIT 1A on the LEFT toward Williamsburg / Richmond
5. Take the Hampton Roads Center Parkway WEST exit – Exit 261A
6. Merge onto Hampton Roads Center Pkwy
7. Turn slight right onto VA-600 N / Big Bethel Road
8. Turn Right onto Towne Center Way
9. End at Topeka's Steakhouse 'N Saloon
