SFBAC- Ambassador Plan

Membership Year 2009-2010

This Ambassador Plan for the San Francisco Bay Area Chapter INCOSE outlines the chapter's plans to communicate events to other interested parties in the community, solicit membership, and seek to increase the interest in Systems Engineering and the mission of INCOSE.

Selecting an Ambassador:

SFBAC-INCOSE Ambassadors may or may not be INCOSE members. Pools for selection of Ambassadors include other local professional societies, representatives from local universities, non-INCOSE members that have attended or presented at past chapter events, and others from organizations that have in some fashion been associated with INCOSE in the past. The Director for Membership-at-Large will compile a list of potential Ambassadors and review it with the Vice President. The list of candidates will then be presented to the President.

Appointing an Ambassador:

SFBAC-INCOSE Ambassadors are appointed by the President, at the recommendation of the Director for Membership-at-Large. The selection of desired Ambassadors is made during the first month of each new membership year or at the discretion of the Director for Membership-at-Large to fill vacancies or new positions as required. Acceptance of the Ambassador role is requested from each of the selected individuals.

Being an Ambassador:

SFBAC-INCOSE Ambassadors are individuals who can communicate events to interested parties outside of the INCOSE membership pool. These individuals will be responsible for publicizing SFBAC-INCOSE events at their respective organizations, and possibly other local professional societies with which they are affiliated. Ambassadors may also be called upon for hosting events at their company's facilities. The SFBAC Board of Directors will inform all Ambassadors of upcoming events and provide electronic flyers for distribution. Ambassadors are not limited to a defined term of service; however, Ambassadors are asked to serve at least one year after their induction.
