SFBAC- Student Division Plan

Membership Year 2009-2010

This Student Division Plan for the San Francisco Bay Area Chapter INCOSE outlines the chapter's plans to engage academic institutions to initiate and maintain a student division of SFBAC operating under the Student Division constitution and bylaws.

Selection of an Academic Institution:

SFBAC-INCOSE Board of Director members will liaison with local colleges to determine if the conditions as a Student Division have been met. The primary elements to form a Student Division are:

1. Students are willing to join INCOSE and pay dues
2. Take Leadership roles
3. Have a sponsoring faculty member to mentor students and become and INCOSE member.
4. Assist with ensuring operational framework is compatible with University policies.

The assigned college Liaison will compile, and maintain a list of Students and faculty members for review with the SFBAC Board of directors.

Appointing a School Liaison:

SFBAC-INCOSE college liaisons are appointed by the chapter President. The selection of Liaison from volunteering members is made during the first month of each new membership year or at the discretion of the chapter President to fill vacancies, or new positions as required. Acceptance of the college Liaison role is requested from each of the selected individuals.

Being a College Liaison:

SFBAC-INCOSE College Liaison are individuals who can communicate events to interest to the Student Division, maintain a list of Student Division chapter members, and interface with SFBAC Board of Directors as required to maintain an operating student division. The Student Division Liaison will be responsible for publicizing SFBAC-INCOSE events at the respective college and events at INCOSE and within SFBAC. The SFBAC Board of Directors will inform all Liaison members of upcoming events and provide electronic flyers for distribution. Student Division Liaisons are not limited to a defined term of service; however, they are asked to serve at least one year after their induction.
