INCOSE System Engineering Certification Class

In response to our last year survey, SFBAC is planning a tutorial class at the end of August. This will be a two day class on 8/28 & 8/29. The tutorial will cover the Associate and Certified Systems Engineering Professional (ASEP and CSEP) process and a review of the Systems Engineering Handbook, version 3.2, which will be the basis for the certification exam. The certification exam is the same for both ASEP and the CSEP process. Class size is limited to 30 students, and early registration is encouraged.
