The Symposium theme "Engineering Tomorrow's World Today" calls on delegates to address a more complex and technologically sophisticated world, where Systems Engineering and higher-level systems thinking are increasingly needed to handle the challenges of new technologies. Panels in all areas of Systems Engineering are encouraged, with particular focus on the future technical vision for Systems Engineering. All panel discussions must be conducted in English, the official language of the INCOSE 2003 Symposium.

- SE in Biotechnology and/or Medical Applications
- The Future of Requirements Engineering
- Public Health, Safety, the Environment, and Industrial Development

- The Future of SE in Telecomm, Transport, and Internet
- Earth Systems Engineering
- Human Factors/Systems Interfacing Issues
- Future Space Systems
- SE and the Government of the Future
- The Future of Design Methodologies for SE

Panel proposals must specify the topic of the panel and planned panelists, outline the themes and topics that will be debated by the panel, and include a one-page position statement and bio from each panelist. Each panel proposal must specify the panel moderator, who will be the point of contact for the proposal. Panel sessions may differ in length, but proposals should plan for a nominal duration of 90 minutes. Accepted panels are expected to provide a one to four page position statement for each panelist, which will be published in the Symposium proceedings.
