

A Framework and Metrics for Addressing an Agile Enterprise

Abstract. When attempting to design or specify agile solutions for an enterprise with long acquisition timeframes, both the solutions and the enterprise itself must be considered in the same framework to understand the value of time and money spent at one time and performance measured at another. A broad overview of techniques, artifacts, and measurements developed for, and used to, address Enterprise Agility is presented and discussed. Emphasis is placed on treating the distance between both ends of the traditional engineering _V_ in a common framework, and on _virtual_ feedback between operations and design or portfolio management spaces.
