On September 19, 2025, INCOSE Canada hosted a collaborative virtual working group kick-off meeting and officially initiated the taskforce on the four focus areas for immediate progress:

- Integration and Interface Management
- Requirements and Standards
- Competency and Education
- Design Review and Quality Assurance
