FEDERAL WAY LINK EXTENSION

CLIENT: Sound Transit

The Federal Way Link Extension brings Sound Transit's light rail transit (LRT) network south of Angle Lake, just south of Sea-Tac Airport, to the City of Federal Way. Mott MacDonald, as the lead in the South County Transit Partners joint venture, is providing design-build project management services for the project. The 8-mile (13-km) extension is largely elevated, with three new stations and parking garages totaling 3,200 parking spaces. As Sound Transit's largest design-build contract, the team is establishing a framework for efficient delivery on future projects. The project is expected to open for service in 2026, bringing much needed transit services to the growing South King County.
