## Meeting Topic:

***System Functional Modeling using IBM's***

***Rational Rhapsody Software***

## Abstract for the presentation:

This technical presentation will focus on a Systems Engineer, involved with requirements engineering activities. A fifteen minutes slideshow will be followed by a demonstration of IBM's Rational software suite. (i.e., DOORS and Rhapsody)

Requirements definition is a critical part of the development lifecycle, but it is common for system-level requirements to be inconsistent and incomplete. The Rational Solution for Systems and Software Engineering provides process guidance and tooling for model-based System Functional Analysis. The Rational solution applies modeling in a non-implementation way to refine and improve upon system requirements. By visualizing requirements, engineers have a better understanding of intended behavior.

Edmund Mayer is the IBM Rational Systems Practice lead in North America, and specializes in the technical definition and deployment of the Rational Application Lifecycle Management (ALM) solution. Ed has a special interest in modeling, and frequently consults and speaks on the application of modeling throughout this integrated Systems and Software Engineering lifecycle- within requirements engineering, design, implementation, and test. Ed holds a BSEE and MSEE from Missouri University of Science & Technology.
