The 2022 International Symposium is right around the corner, both from a time perspective and locality. IS2022 is being held as a hybrid event with the in-person venue in Detroit Michigan. Registration is open and there are various options to choose from. Over



the six days, there are five technical tracks planned with more that 80 papers or presentations. There are also four keynote speakers planned for the plenary sessions. It is anticipated that individuals from at least 25 countries will be represented, covering 24 application domains and 37 separate topic area.
