Abstract

Needs and requirements are the common threads that tie all lifecycle concepts for a System of Interest (SOI) together. Needs present a stakeholder view of the SOI in terms of what the stakeholders need from the SOI once delivered. The requirements, design, and system will be validated against the integrated set of needs defined for the SOI. Project success and acceptance of the SOI depends on successfully passing system validation. The design input requirements present a technical view of the SOI in terms of what the SOI must do to meet the needs. The design and SOI will be verified against the set of design input requirements. As defined in the INCOSE Guide for Writing Requirements (GfWR), the design input requirements are transformed from the integrated set of needs defined for the SOI. For the design input requirements to have the characteristics defined in the GfWR, the needs from which they are transformed must also have the characteristics of well-formed needs and sets of needs as also defined in the GfWR. In this presentation Lou will discuss the activities involved in understanding what the stakeholders need the system to do before transforming those needs into an integrated set of needs. This topic is also the focus of a seminar that Lou will be presenting for the Chapter in the Spring of 2022. Lou will outline the approach we are planning for this Seminar.


