Abstract

Both hard skill and soft skills are important for the Systems Engineer. One important, but often overlooked, soft skill is the ability to ask questions. This presentation explores why questions are important to the Systems Engineer, identifies some key types of questions, and introduces two tools that can be used to ask better questions, the Five Whys and the Six Honest Serving Men.


