- First Expo prior to Curiosity Landing (08/2012)
- Purpose was Several-Fold:
 - Become a Premier Science, Technology, Engineering & Math (STEM) Outreach Event
 - Preview Unique Challenges of That Mission
 - Later Expanded to Include Other JPL Mission Updates
 - Allow Local (LA & OC) Societies to Exhibit
 - Many Diverse & Active Societies
 - Each supports One or More STEM Careers
 - Each needs More Volunteers
 - Help Advertise Their Upcoming Events
 - Plan & Promote Multi-Society Events
