Chapter meetings

Biggest reason for attending is professional development (10/15), networking (9/15), and relevance to work (7/15) – Conclusion: continue twice yearly social events, meeting site for face-to-face interaction, high quality speakers, and relevant-to-work topics.

Global Meet Chapter Meeting Broadcast

15 of 15 respondents aware (didn't ask if they use) – Conclusion: continue GM broadcasts.

Twice yearly Social Events

9/15 respondents usually attend, main reason for not attending: location not convenient 2/15, not interested in activities 1/15, time of day not convenient 1/15, love socials, but have schedule issues on my end 1/15, circumstances interfere but plan to attend in future 1/15. – Conclusion: continue Friday as-best-scheduling.

Importance of Chapters four Goals

- Regional Voice: 14/15 somewhat or very important.

- Rewarding Activities: 13/15 somewhat or very important, 1/15 neutral, 1/15 don't know.

Conclusion – continue with the same goals.

Satisfaction of Chapters Goal Achievement

- Regional Voice: 9/15 somewhat or very satisfied, 4/15 neutral, 2/15 don't know.
- Professional Development: 12/15 somewhat or very satisfied, 3/15 neutral.
- Rewarding Activities: 11/15 somewhat or very satisfied, 2/15 neutral, 2/15 somewhat dissatisfied.
- Reliable/Effective Chapter: 13/15 somewhat or very satisfied, 2/15 neutral.

Conclusion – continue with the same approach generally, give some additional attention to Rewarding Activities.

One of the 2 dissatisfied offered: More learning opportunities for non-SE people to learn about what SE is and develop their skills in SE.
