Biographies

Dr Juan Llorens is Professor at the Informatics Department of the Carlos III University of Madrid – Spain.

He received his MS degree in Industrial Engineering from the ICAI Polytechnic School at the UPC University in Madrid in 1986, Spain, and his PhD in Industrial Engineering and robotics at the Carlos III University of Madrid, Spain in 1996.



He started his own company in 1987 dealing with Artificial Intelligence applied to Database systems, named Knowledge Engineering SL (KE). Dr. Llorens worked as technical director in KE and as Marketing Director in Advanced Vision Technologies until 1992, when he joined the Carlos III University. Since 2003 he is Professor at the Carlos III University of Madrid. His main subject is Knowledge Centric Systems Engineering and Reuse, which he teaches in the Informatics studies at the University.

Dr Llorens is the leader of the KR Group (Knowledge Reuse Group) within the University. In 1998 he was invited to the Högskolan på Åland (HÅ) (Åland, Finland). From 1998 to 2008 he split his educational activities between Madrid's University and the HÅ, where he taught different Software Engineering subjects.

Since 2008, based on a funded agreement, The REUSE Company, a brand of the spin-off organization named Knowledge Centric Solutions, has outsourced all its R&D activities to the Knowledge Reuse Group of the Carlos III University. In this context, Dr Llorens can defend TRC's CTO role within his professorship. His current research involves the study of knowledge technologies and system engineering techniques integration towards Software, Systems and Knowledge quality, traceability, interoperability, reasoning and Reuse.

He is the leader of the INCOSE (International Council on Systems Engineering, www.incose.org) Ontologies Working Group, member as well of the Requirements Working Group and he is the President Elect of INCOSE Spain (AEIS).



Dr Jennifer Narkevicius is CEO of Jenius LLC, a woman-owned, veteran-owned small business specializing in Systems Engineering, Human Systems Integration (HSI), and Human Factors Engineering (HFE) and focusing on complex programs. Her work focuses on incorporation of humans into systems from research to requirements definition, system design and development and test and evaluation. Working across domains her current research on assured human control of hybrid intelligence systems including identifying, refining and documenting the resulting architecture requirements. Concurrently, she is a professional freelance harpist, in demand as a performer, teacher, and arranger. Dr. Narkevicius is a member and past co-chair of INCOSE Human Systems Integration Working Group and of the Human Factors and Ergonomics Society. She is Past Treasurer of INCOSE. She holds a Ph.D. in Cognitive Psychology, MS in Systems Engineering, MS in Adult Development Psychology, MA in Special Education of Gifted and Talented students and is a Certified Music Practitioner.

Dr Michael Do worked in the defense industry for both Raytheon Corporation and the U.S. Army. As a systems engineer assigned with Raytheon, Michael was responsible for “cradle to grave” engineering, manufacturing, and development of missile weapon systems. This cradle to grave systems engineering include proposals, requirements, architecture, design, performance, integration, and risk management. As an engineer officer serving in the Army Corps of Engineers, Michael is responsible for leading, training, developing, coaching, and mentoring of current and future leaders of the U.S. Army. Previous assignments include staff engineer, construction engineer, operations, civil-military, and interagency.



Michael holds a B.S. and M.S. degrees in Systems Engineering, a M.Eng. in Engineering Management, and a Ph.D. in Mining and Systems Engineering from the University of Arizona.

Courtney Wright is the program manager for the International Council on Systems Engineering (INCOSE) Certification program. As the Program Manager, she is directly responsible for the program's external interfaces, marketing, and ensuring program compliance with INCOSE's internal policies. Prior to joining INCOSE in 2012, Ms. Wright was a consultant with Booz Allen Hamilton, and SRA International. Throughout her career she has been involved with organizations such as the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA), the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA), the United States Air Force (USAF), and the United States National Geospatial-Intelligence Agency (NGA). She has a bachelor's degree in Mechanical Engineering from the University of Virginia, a Master's in Operations Research from Georgia Tech, and has been an INCOSE Certified Systems Engineering Professional (CSEP) since 2007.
