



Ways to Record

There are many ways to record your presentation for later playback to an online conference, or later uploading to YouTube or another video storage system. Here are the three options covered here:

- 1. Recording with PowerPoint
- 2. Recording with Zoom
- 3. Recording with Open Broadcaster System (OBS)

Recording with Open Broadcaster System (OBS)

OBS is more complex than PowerPoint or Zoom, but is a wonderful free program that essentially turns your computer into a TV studio. OBS has tremendous flexibility for how you format and build your presentation, from PowerPoint, software demonstrations, even multuple cameras.
