WG PURPOSE/MISSION

The purpose of the ArchWG is to expand the practice of architecture in Systems Engineering and advance the body of knowledge. Architecture is an integral part of the concepts and practice of Systems Engineering (and other disciplines) and must evolve with ongoing advancements whatever their origin. Therefore a standing working group facilitates and focuses ongoing advances in all extents and types of Enterprise and System Architecture and supports collaboration across INCOSE, across disciplines and with other international bodies that have a common interest in SE-based architecture.

WG GOAL(S)

The stakeholders of the ArchWG are practitioners and researchers in all kinds of Enterprise and System Architecture. The ArchWG seeks to accomplish standing goals and goals established each year at the INCOSE IW event.

Standing goals are defined as follows:

- Advance and evolve the architecture body of knowledge
- Promote the use and practice of architecture principles in systems engineering
- Share best practices for the use of architecture in enterprise and systems engineering projects
- Develop the practice of architecture within ArchWG members? home organizations
- Expand the effort in architecture related standards and specifications.

These goals are conducted in association with other bodies where appropriate. For example, over several years the ISO/IEC working group JTC1/SC7/WG42 has been a ?customer? for ArchWG input. Collaborations with the IEEE and the OMG have been established.
