



SAFETY MEASURES COVID -19 - What to expect on site at the International Workshop?



REQUIRED: Proof of COVID-19 Vaccination or negative COVID-19 test

Attendees are required to be fully vaccinated before coming to the event and will be asked to provide proof of vaccination or a negative PCR COVID-19 test (no auto/at home test) result taken within the last two days of arrival at the venue for the event. Please make sure to bring your vaccination/test record documents with you. Once you have provided your proof of vaccination or negative COVID-19 test and picked up your badge, you will not need to verify your vaccination status again.



Masks

Masks are required indoors in the State of California. Attendees will be required to wear masks when they are inside the hotel property.



Food & Beverage

Meals will be adjusted to avoid self-served food and drink.



Meeting spacing

Seating capacity will be adjusted to allow for physical distancing.



Traffic Light System

To ensure the safety and comfort of all the attendees, INCOSE has adopted a "Traffic Light System". This is a color-coding system that allows attendess to more easily signify to others how comfortable they are with social mixing. Green: I am comfortable with social mixing, including contact like shaking hands. Yellow: I am comfortable with some social mixing but not with physical contact. Red: I am not comfortable with physical contact and would prefer to stay socially distanced.



Healthy habits

- Wash your hands regularly
- Wear your mask at all times indoor
- Wear your mask outdoor when you attend a large event
- Keep physical distance (six feet)



What will INCOSE provide to each attendee?

- A set of ten masks
- An individual hand sanitizer
- Hand sanitization stations will be placed throughout IW2022 venues to
- encourage frequent hand sanitization
- Contact numbers of local health services

INCOSE, along with the Marriott Hotel, will adhere to the current health precautions in effect when IW2022 convenes. The local jurisdictions are the City of Torrance, the County of Los Angeles, and the State of California. Regulations are evaluated weekly, based on new cases and hospitalizations.
