OVERVIEW: With INCOSE's new IT infrastructure and supporting tools, creating & maintaining a modern, professional looking Chapter website is now not only possible, but much easier and convenient than you might think. However, there is a learning curve, and getting off to a good start is important. This is a PRACTICAL workshop to engage Chapter volunteers.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND: This workshop is intended for Chapter volunteers with one or more of the following roles:

- 1. <u>Webmasters</u> As a primary contact for the Chapter's public website, webmasters are knowledgeable and proficient with INCOSE's web tool, SiteFinity, and may eventually learn to use "advanced" features (e.g., modifying page structure & layout).
- 2. <u>Content Editors</u> Content Editors are chapter volunteers who need to quickly/easily modify webpage content within the existing page structure & layout (e.g., to post announcements, add detailed text and links, fix errors, swap in new images, etc.).
- 3. <u>Chapter Leaders</u> Chapters officers, directors, committee chairs, IT specialists, and other key volunteers may wish to understand (and help determine) website purpose, scope and objectives to perform optimally within a "system of systems."
