

Government Intellectual Property Release for Materials

Scope: This form is used when the paper is produced by employees or contractors of a government (e.g., US, UK)

Instructions: The author (or in case of multiple authors, each author completes a separate form) shall sign this IP release form. If the author is a U.S. government employee who is submitting materials that were prepared in furtherance of their official duties, then this IP release form should also be signed by a U.S. government employee with authority to bind the U.S. government (e.g., a contracting officer). Author's IP Agreement and Release:

I, ______("Author") will retain ownership of intellectual property rights (including copyright and related rights) to the Materials and grant to the International Council on Systems Engineering ("INCOSE") a non-exclusive, fully paid up, royalty-free, perpetual, worldwide license to use, publish, record, print, live stream, exploit, copy, assign, offer for sale, and otherwise distribute the "Materials," as defined by this Agreement and Release.

Under this Agreement and Release, the "Materials" include work submitted to INCOSE for publication, including work presented at INCOSE symposia, regional conferences, working groups, chapter meetings, and other events ("Conference Sessions,") such as:

- Manuscripts, papers, and work products;
- Presentations, agendas, supplements, and written materials made for or used in Conference Sessions;
 and
- Recordings of all Conference Sessions, including plenary, paper, and panel sessions ("Recordings.")

By agreeing to this Release, Author grants INCOSE the right to video record, photograph or otherwise record the Materials in connection with the Conference Sessions to which Author has contributed. INCOSE is not obligated to use the Event Content or the Presentation Materials.

Author hereby waives any and all intellectual property claims including, but not limited to, trademark and copyright infringement claims, defamation, right to publicity and privacy claims arising out of or in connection with, any use, alternation, or use in any composite form of the Materials.

Author further hereby releases and discharges INCOSE from any and all liability arising out of or in connection with the making, producing, reproducing, processing, exhibiting, distribution, publishing, or transmitting by any means or otherwise use of the Materials.

The first page of any Materials submitted to INCOSE shall contain a copyright notice as follows: "Copyright © (insert year) by (insert author name or assignee). Permission granted to INCOSE to publish and use." This marking requirement does not apply if Author is a U.S. government employee and the Materials were prepared in furtherance of the Author's official duties.

Unless Author is a U.S. government employee submitting Materials that were prepared in furtherance of their official duties, this Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the substantive laws of the State of California without reference to principles of conflicts of law or choice of law that could trigger the application of the laws of any other jurisdiction, and all disputes arising under or related to this Agreement shall be brought in state or federal courts within the State of California. If Author is a U.S. government employee submitting Materials that were prepared in furtherance of their official duties, then this Agreement shall be governed and construed in accordance with federal law.
