1. Be an INCOSE member.
2. Send statement of interest to ltmys@incose.net with subject line of “LTMYS2 Volunteer Reviewer: Your Name” by November 15 (sooner is appreciated).
3. Please include a summary of your writing/editing experience (all levels welcome!).
4. Indicate if you were a volume one letter writer.

Reviewers will be provided:

1. General guidance for reviewing the letters.
2. A style guide to help format the letters, as needed.
3. Guidance on the expected content of the letter.
4. A rating form to use to evaluate the letter and provide feedback to the author and to rate the acceptance level recommended for the letter.
5. A schedule to complete the reviews.

Reviewers should expect to review between three and five letters for the publication. In some cases, a follow-up review for a re-submission may be needed.
