Submitted letters should:

- 1. Be 750 1000 words in length.
- 2. Appeal to a younger audience in their mid-teens to early 20s.
- 3. Include insights, lessons learned, and advice on considerations for a career in systems engineering related to one's own experiences.
- 4. Expand on system engineering / systems thinking concepts, principles, and approaches.
- 5. Not be a review of one's accomplishments, as in a resume or a vitae.

Submitters will:

- 1. Email ltmys@incose.net with your statement of interest to write a letter and to receive further instructions the earlier the better.
- Review volume one letters to become familiar with LTMYS: HSECML.
- 3. Use the template provided for the initial submission.
- 4. Include "Now" and "Then" pictures.
- 5. Send the letter submission to ltmys@incose.net with the subject line of "LTMYS2: Your name" by November 15, 2025.

Letters will go through a double-blind review and may be accepted or rejected with the following status:

- 1. Not accepted to the current volume.
- 2. Possibly accepted with major updates needed.
- 3. Accepted with minor updates needed.

Please note that accepted letters will go through a final editorial process.
