John S. Clouet was the INCOSE President in 2001. He was also a member of the INCOSE Board of Directors for 5 years, 2 years as the Southwest Regional Director and 3 years in the INCOSE President cycle. John was a strong advocate for the INCOSE Systems Engineering Certification Program and was the committee chairman for certification from the beginning of the initiative to the first Beta test at the INCOSE annual Symposium held in Washington D.C. in 2002. John was also the INCOSE President and supporter that helped to reshape the INCOSE leadership organizational structure, which included the change to a 4 year term for the INCOSE Presidency. John was the last person to hold the office of Past President.

John was a Senior Systems Engineer and Project Manager with Northrop Grumman (formerly TRW) for over 25 years. In 2002 he moved into Continuous Process Improvement and Process Effectiveness.
