Position Description:

The Co-Chair, Certification Advisory Group is an elected role, by the Certification Advisory Group, and serves a one-year term, starting at the end of the International Workshop, prior to serving as Chair, Certification Advisory Group

Responsibilities:

- Chairs the Certification Advisory Group, in the absence of the Chair, Certification Advisory Group which:
- Recommends policy revisions in the Certification program.
- Advises the INCOSE Board of Directors on Certification matters.
- Approves Certification Assessment Reviewer appointments.
- Adjudicates certification split decisions and denial appeals.
- Creates training material for new and returning Certification Assessment Reviewers

Authority:

- Assists the Certification Advisory Group Chair in leading the Certification Advisory Group
- Recommends policy revisions to the INCOSE Board of Directors via the Certification Advisory Group Chair, the Associate Director, Certification and the Services Director

Accountability:

- As stipulated in the INCOSE Bylaws and CER-100
- Compliance with directives on conflict of interest and all policies and procedures of the organization

Required Skills:

- Demonstrated dedication to INCOSE's mission, values and organizational growth
 - Current individual INCOSE Member.
 - Holds either a Certified Systems Engineering Professional (CSEP) or Expert Systems Engineering Professional (ESEP) qualification
 - Holds a current Certification Assessment Reviewer approval.
 - Strong oral and written communications skills
- Able to communicate effectively across international and cultural boundaries
