Author's IP Agreement and Release:

I, _____ (“Author”) will retain ownership of intellectual property rights (including copyright and related rights) to the Materials and I grant to the International Council on Systems Engineering (“INCOSE”) a non-exclusive, fully paid up, royalty-free, perpetual, worldwide license to use, publish, record, print, live stream, exploit, copy, assign, offer for sale, and otherwise distribute the “Materials,” as defined by this Agreement and Release.

INCOSE requires Author to obtain any needed approvals from employers, customers, and assignees to meet legal obligations for publication or use by INCOSE and affiliated societies of Materials. INCOSE will not confer with or request approvals from others than Author or assignee for publication rights.
