CSER 2027 will explore modern complex systems and the user, societal, organizational, physical, and process elements tied to them.

Hosted in the heart of Huntsville and next to Redstone Arsenal, NASA Marshall Space Flight Center, and the Cummings Research Park, special topics at CSER 2027 will explore advancing the aerospace, defense, and space systems and their engineering ecosystems.

Types of Submissions

The following types of submissions are welcome:

Full Papers

(maximum 10 pages, excluding reference list, which may extend to additional pages) for peer review and podium presentation. Accepted and presented full papers will be published in electronic proceedings.

Extended Abstracts

(maximum 4 pages, excluding reference list, which may extend to additional pages) for podium presentation. Extended abstracts will not be published in electronic proceedings.

Poster Abstracts

(maximum 2 pages) to be considered for poster presentation and/or lightning talk. Poster abstracts will not be published.

Proposals for panels, tutorials, workshops, discussions, and/or interactive sessions (maximum 2 pages) on special topics of interest to the CSER community are highly encouraged. Please reach out to the technical program committee to discuss any special arrangements.

Student-led full papers and extended abstracts are eligible for consideration for the Barry Boehm SERC doctoral research award. Finalists will present in a special session and compete for a cash prize.

Authors must submit using the CSER 2027 template provided on the website. Full paper submissions not accepted may be invited to be reconsidered as extended abstract or poster submissions.
